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Welcome!

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PROCLAMATION

Welcome to the place where YHWH Elohim speaks, and we listen.

My name is Elvira; I am a writer, entrepreneur, and the steward of Christ's prophecies here at the Fruit Factory. I was chosen out of the tribe of Judah and prepared by YHWH to labour on this field; charging me with making heard His trumpet call and voice, revealing His mind, will, judgments, exhortations, ways, and works as they pertain to the final events that will preface His return.

John 15: Our foundational Scripture

'I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.'—John 15:1-8.

Israel: Yah's first fruit

'For a mere moment I have forsaken you, But with great mercies I will gather you. With a little wrath I hid My face from you for a moment; But with everlasting kindness I will have mercy on you," Says the Lord, your Redeemer.'—Isaiah 54:7-8

It is to true Israel that I have been sent first and foremost with the core message that the time of her regathering and reconciliation to YHWH is at hand. That's why the reader of The Fruit Factory will notice that all proclamations here have a connection to true Israel in some way, shape or form.

True Israel is not the people currently occupying the land of Israel as we know it. She was scattered 2000 years ago and is yet to be regathered. The hoax that happened in 1948 was one of Satan's great deceptions. But worry not, for El-Shaddai will make sure that the scales are balanced, and His true people returned to their homeland.

Christ is ready to bring the true bloodline of Jacob out of the pits of historical and spiritual darkness, into His light. It is time for the fulfilment of His promises to her as He prepares His grand return in glory!

The Church: Yahshua, the Christ's bride

'For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek.' — Romans 1:16

This ministry is also a trumpet call to those not part of true Israel but who either already have been, or are willing to be:

- (1) Saved by accepting Yahshua's sacrifice on the cross as atonement for their sins,
- (2) Born again through the Holy Spirit and,
- (3) Consecrated to a life set apart for YHWH in sanctification and holiness.

This church shall be grafted onto Israel to dwell in the promised land together. The church is a co-heir of Abraham's promises and shall receive the fullness of YHWH's blessings as it is written in the books of the prophets and the law of Moses.

'That the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel, of which I became a minister according to the gift of the grace of God given to me by the effective working of His power.' — Ephesians 3: 6-7

The following statement is what YHWH, our Elohim, has to proclaim about this ministry and the worker He appointed to labour on this field.

Thus says YHWH:

'You [Elvira] are My prophet and scribe.

I tell you things and you write them down. Whoever rejects what you write has rejected Me. Tell them this is what I, El-Shaddai, have said and ordained.

The Wedding Preparation

Ladies and gentlemen, if you were invited to a wedding that was supposed to start at 5 PM, would you start getting ready only once your eyes could confirm the reception had begun? Only after your friends and family send you pictures of the bride and groom entering the venue?

I am going to speak to the men here, as those appointed to be the heads of the family in the Bible. Gentlemen, would you not start getting ready at least an hour or more earlier to make sure that you have enough time to shower, comb your hair, trim your beard, apply your best shea and cocoa butter lotions—no ashiness shall be tolerated—and put on your most lavish tuxedo?

You would have probably factored in some extra time to wait for your wife, because she always takes longer to get ready; also some time to give instructions to the kids and the nanny about what must be done in your absence; let's not forget the time to take great pictures before heading out—because that level of elegance must absolutely be immortalised.

Then, both of you would drive to the venue, an activity for which you would have considered some buffer time, in case of traffic, or if you get lost or miss a turn or two on the way there because Maps doesn't always get everything right, and we sometimes come across deranged people on the road who drive cars in ways only YHWH understands (assuming that those 'people' are not you).

Now, if your wife is the one driving then you will definitely need to add a good extra twenty minutes because... Well, you know why! We don't have to spell it out now, do we?

Once you finally arrive, parking cannot be underestimated because it could take a good quarter hour to find the right spot, especially if it's at the heart of the city on a Friday or Saturday night. If your wife is wearing heels then you must add an extra set of minutes for the walk from the parking lot to the reception hall. Trust me, she will not rush in those heels; she won't risk getting sweaty—letting all the efforts she put into polishing her make up go to waste. Not a chance.

Wait—

As I was writing all of these elements of preparation to attend a wedding, a light bulb went off in my head, and I think I may have solved one of the greatest mysteries of our modern times.

Friends, I believe I have uncovered the reason why black people are late to... about... everything. Black people will start showing up to a 5 PM event at around 6:30 to 7 PM—and this is me being incredibly reasonable. If the event is taking place in Africa, don't even bother getting there before 8:30.

It's one of those things that I sometimes talk about with my loved ones and we laugh, saying, 'It's just how we are are.' But I think I finally got it! It's because we never think about the time it actually takes to do all the preparation for the event *the day of*. Instead, we dwell

on how good everybody is going to look, how cool the wedding is going to be, how much the newly weds love each other, what gifts we are going to bring, etc.

It's so funny. Sometimes it is at 4 PM that a cousin decides that she'll cook 3 large pots of food for the reception (that is supposed to start at 5), and she drags you to the grocery store, so now it's your problem too. There you go, rushing and hustling throughout the afternoon; and as if that wasn't enough, your hair ends up smelling like fish—or worse, garlic. So you also have that to take care of now, on top of every thing else.

What's really unique too, is that we don't think it's a big deal. We'll just get there when we get there. Besides, we know everybody is going to be late too any way, right? The newly weds aren't showing up before 10 PM—that's for sure. So we're good.

Today's believers in Christ are exactly the same.

We are all so excited about an 'event', may it be going to heaven, being raptured, or seeing the Day of the Lord, that we have spent centuries talking about everything related to that escape, except the preparation required to actually be ready for it.

We are either caught up in dead religious rituals that do nothing for the soul, or we are too absorbed in God's love and the mansions that are awaiting us in heaven. Things like blessings, divine inheritance, prosperity, etc. is what we are focused on. 'God is good.... all the time... God is good.' See?

We know all the 'Maranatha' songs, don't we? But have we appropriately measured and meditated on the conditions in which Christ is to make that grandiose return? The kind of distress the world will be in—hardships that we, too, will have to endure?

Moreover, we have underestimated the time we have left for Yahshua's return. We are waiting to get the text that says 'The bridegroom is here,' to start getting ready; and we think that we can text back 'I'm on my way,' when in reality we haven't even gotten dressed yet.

We need to wake up, urgently.

'Be sober, be vigilant.' —1 Peter 5:8.

Beware! Unlike our weddings here on earth, the wedding supper of the Lamb does not only have a very exclusive guest list, but also a rigorous timeline. There is a precise moment

when Yahshua will slam the doors shut! If when He does so you are still outside, that will be it for you.

The state of our garments

That being said, one thing that cannot be denied is that black people may be late to your wedding, but they will show up looking as sharp as baby fingernails (It is astonishing how sharp the small nails on those tiny fingers can get, isn't it?).

When I say looking sharp, I'm talking sleek clothes with perfect ironing, skin glistening, hair laid, shoes shining—the whole package. They'll even prepare a fun dance routine to make sure you have a good time. But that's not all. It will be a dance routine that all the black people at the event somehow all know by heart even though they couldn't have rehearsed it in advance. It's some kind of super power.

If only the followers of Christ's garments were as sleek for the big day, but we are looking rather ratchet. This is supposed to be *our* wedding, by the way, which makes our lack of preparedness even more staggering.

Imagine waiting for your wedding day for thousands of years, when you finally get spend eternity with your first love and when the time for it finally comes, you show up late, wearing rags and looking crusty—cracked lips, ashy skin and all. What a tragedy.

It is written:

'Let us rejoice and exult and give Him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His bride **has made herself ready**; to her it has been granted to be clothed with fine linen, bright and pure— for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.'—Revelation 19: 7-8.

'Blessed are those who **wash their robes**, so that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter by the gates into the city.' — Revelation 22:14

Yet, the bride has been made to believe that she would be 'raptured' out of the tribulation, before she prove her faithfulness to the Bridegroom. She thinks herself too precious to suffer for Christ's sake. But I have been sent to remind her that she was warned by

the Bridegroom to 'let no one deceive you.' It is the testing by fire, the washing of the robes, that qualifies us to be called 'Bride' and wear that fine linen garment, bright and pure.

We think we are going to heaven, but do not act differently from unbelievers—whatsoever. We think we are 'special' in Christ. *He* was special, yes, but are we? Are we real Christ-ians or are merely using His name in vain? Is true Israel truly the apple of YHWH's eye? We are quick to claim it, but do we *act* like it?

Time is running out

Matthew 24, Luke 21 and Mark 13 document Yahshua's own words to His disciples about the end times.

'And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. All these are the beginning of sorrows. Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another.' —Matthew 24: 6-10.

What Christ meant was, 'When you start thinking that things are bad, take heart because you've seen nothing yet. You will actually be executed for My name's sake.'

It's going to be a tough journey, but the good news is that we are not alone; we have YHWH Elohim in our corner and He left us His word, which is our sword and the guiding lamp at our feet that will keep us alive in these times, as King David once wrote:

'The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart. The commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes. The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever. The judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, Yea, than much fine gold; sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover by them Your servant is warned, and in keeping them there is great reward.'—Psalm 19:7-11.

By the way...

'Yahshua' is simply Jesus' name in Hebrew. Various scholars have argued for spellings and/or pronunciations like Yehoshua or Yeshua, which are variations of *Joshua*, but we prefer to stick with Yahshua as meaning, 'Yah/YHWH saves.'
